**Let's Talk Train the Trainer (Module 5) Application:** Deadline June 21, 2019

ECEBC is pleased to invite applications for its Let's Talk Train the Trainer Program.

**Let's Talk Trainers:**

- Co-present the 4-module teacher training (as per the Facilitators' Manual for Training Trainers and following the Let's Talk Teacher Training Manual)
- Participate in the Let's Talk evaluation process and work with ECEBC to improve quality of programming.
- Contact ECEBC regarding any problems or concerns that arise.
- Contact the teachers they trained to encourage program implementation
- Participate in vCOP and other team growth activities at least once annually.
- Deliver training in a manner that is consistent with the ECEBC Code of Ethics.

**Training Objectives**

By the end of Module 5 participants will be:

- familiar with the contents of the Teachers Training Manual and the training.
- aware of how to honour the needs of adult-learners while taking overall responsibility for time-management.
- able to problem-solve challenging situations that arise in training.
- able to facilitate discussions of sensitive issues.

- aware of their role as trainers, the role of ECEBC and training site hosts.
- familiar with the process of setting up a teacher training session in collaboration with ECEBC a host organization (where applicable).

To be designated as a trainer for Let's Talk and receive a certificate, individuals must have successfully completed the 3-day Training for Trainers and implemented at least one teacher training session. A certificate of successful completion will be issued by ECEBC when a participant demonstrates required knowledge and skills. Certificates and upon receipt of a certification package.

**Eligibility Criteria:**

The ideal candidate:

- Has been an ECE or Primary School Classroom Teacher for at least two years (past expectation five years as candidates need to be able to 'hold a group') and
- Has implemented the LT Program with children for at least two years in recent years and/or a combination of equivalent comparable skills and experience.
- Demonstrates capacity to lead groups working with sensitive content
- Agrees to train with a teaching partner at least once annually within designated region.
- Willingness to learn
- Experience teaching adults is preferred
- Some preparatory work will be assigned in advance of the in-person training.

*Please spread the word to someone who might be a strong co-trainer in your region. For sustainability and impact, an ideal situation could be a region that has at least one Early Childhood Educator and one Kindergarten teacher willing to be trained together.*

**Fees:** Free of charge in BC thanks to generous sponsor. Meals and materials included.

ECEBC will reimburse approved travel and/or staff replacement. If you require financial support to participate, please outline the need below:
